This needs to be done no later than September 5. If you have not done so, by then, you will be assigned a static time based on what is still available.

The Saturday evening Banquet will be held at The Knights of Columbus Hall. The cost will be \$25 per person. The banquet will be held from 7-11pm.

# **Driving directions to the ORVRCF field:**


#### From I-65:

Take I-65 to Louisville, Ky Exit I-65 onto I-64 West toward St. Louis/New Albany, In. Cross into Indiana via Sherman Minton Bridge. Take first exit right into New Albany, In. Turn right onto State Street (Approx. three blocks) Turn right onto Main Street (Approx. four blocks) Continue west until you see a large Thorntons station on the left. Main road bears to the right. Stay straight on Hwy 111. In approx. 6 miles you will see Harrah's Horseshoe Casino. Continue for another 12 miles. When you see the ROSEWOOD sign on the right, look to your left front and you will see the field. Entrance is about ½ mile on left.
